## How to Make Shadow Puppets

#### **Materials**

- black card stock: 80-90 lb is my favourite paper weight for puppets; 65 lb is a little thin, but may be better for cutting with scissors and a hobby knife
- bamboo skewers for sticks
- puppet designs: you will find my puppet designs to be in JPEG format – that way, you can use them for printing on paper and cutting by hand or for importing into the software of a silhouette cutting machine

You can try making puppets in the following ways:

- 1. By cutting them with scissors and a hobby knife
- By using a silhouette cutting machine (<u>Silhouette Cameo tutorial</u> or <u>Cricut tutorial</u>)
- 3. By printing the designs on printable transparent film
